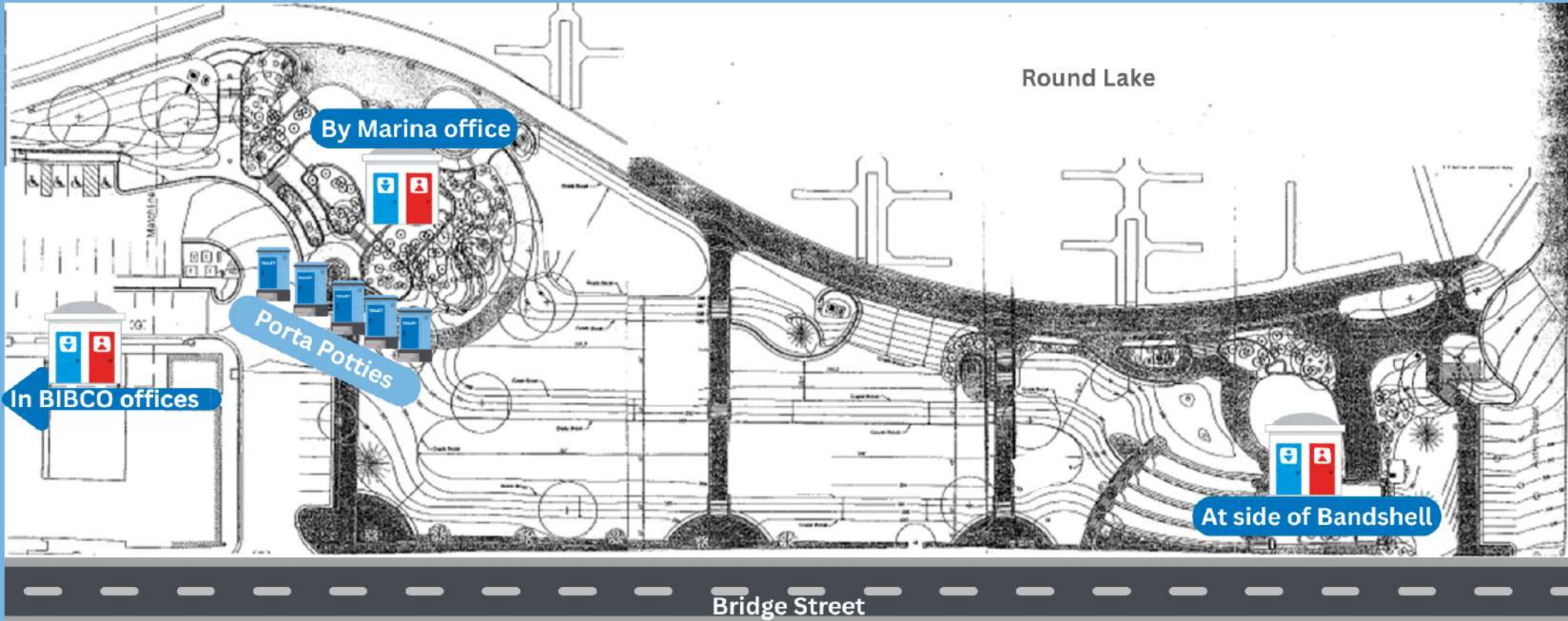

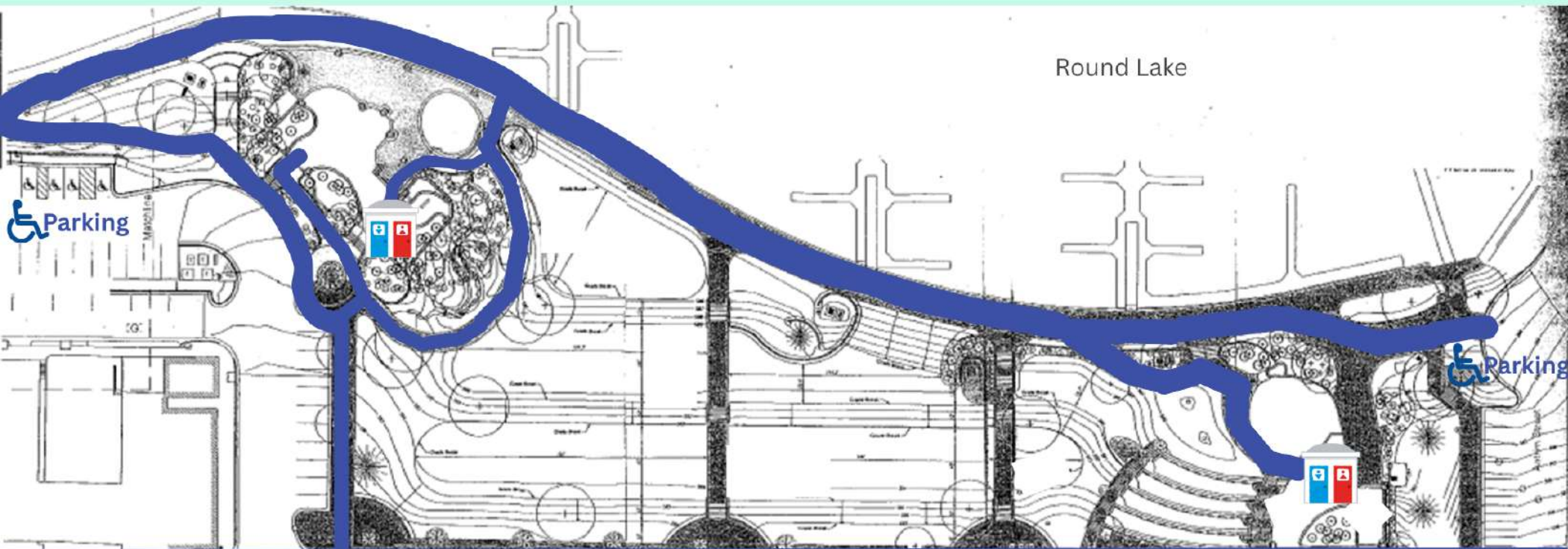

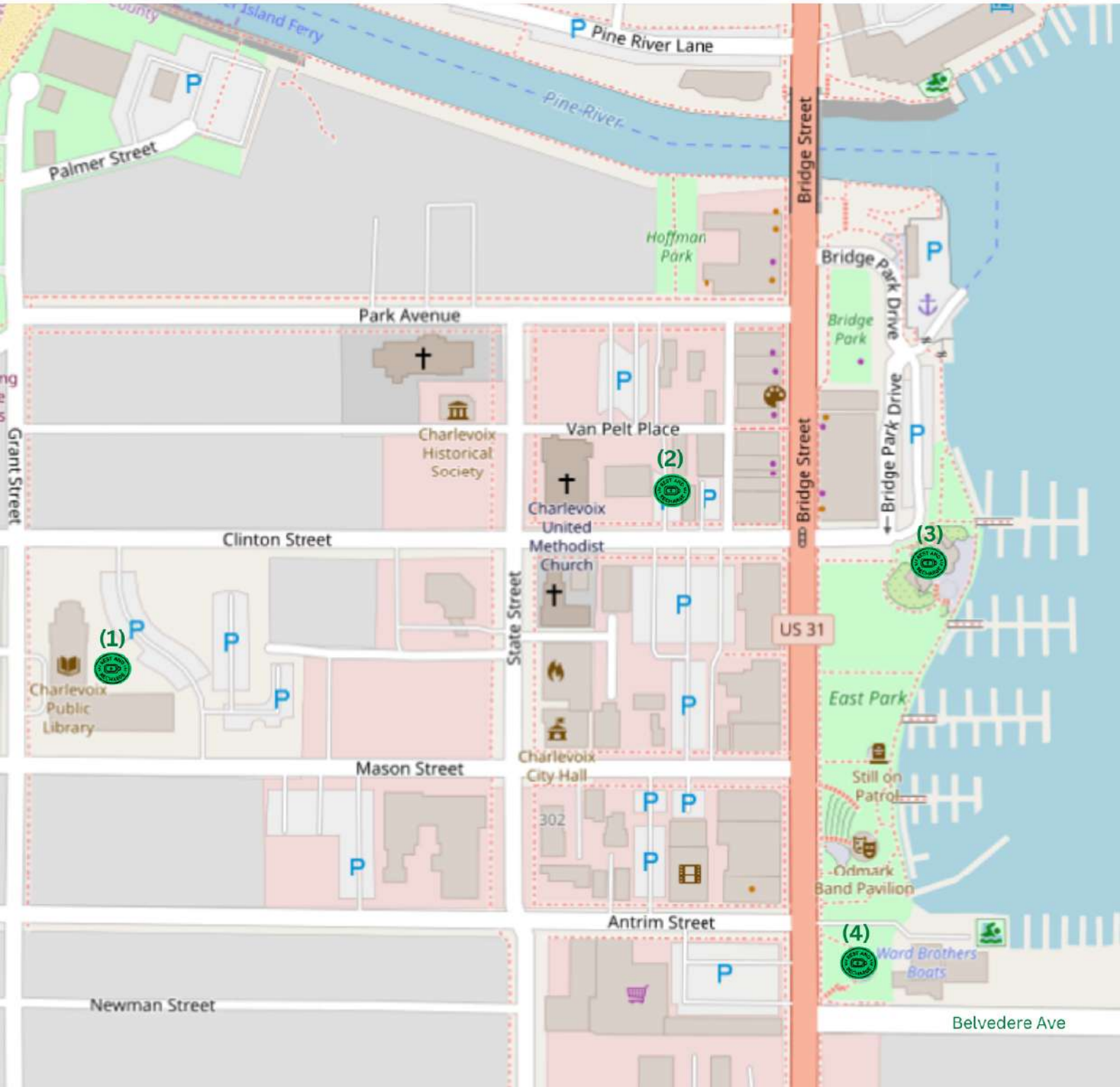

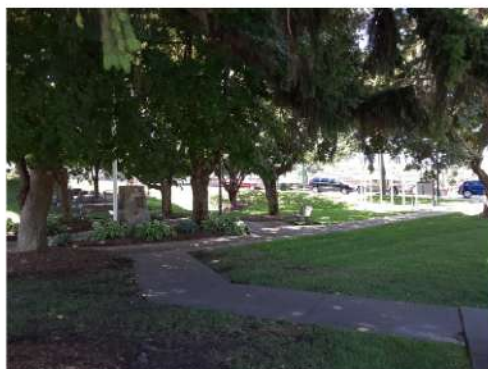

- If your child fits in a stroller, consider using it
- Create a visual schedule of your Festival plans
- Keep routine as much as possible
- Bring snacks
- Review the “Rest & Recharge” locations

- Festival activities with lower sensory stimulation:
 - Cottage Croquet
 - Bingo
 - Fire Department Open House
 - Free movie
 - Carnival tends to be less crowded earlier in the day
 - Family Fun Zone
 - Meet the Airshow Pilots (when applicable)
